IMPORTANT NOTES:

- ~ If a family wants to register multiple sleds under different family members names, the head of household should fill out the "Participant Name" and each family member can fill out the "Owner" with their name for each sled registered.
- ~ Snowmobiles which are clearly registered in the incorrect class will be switched to the correct class to ensure integrity of the class. The Show Director has final say.
- ~ UNRESTORED CLASS allows touch up paint on skis and suspension only. Wear items such as fuel line, skags, and slides may be replaced. Replacement windshield is allowed. Does not allow repainted hoods, repainted or mirror-like polished tunnels, reupholstered seats, or reproduction decals.
- ~ CUSTOM CLASS is for any snowmobile customized by the owner. Includes custom hood, custom fiberglass work, custom windshield, a clone or replica, hand-built or containing multiple parts from another make or model.
- ~ Snowmobiles must be capable of running to be judged.
(i.e., have an engine, carburetor, fuel line, gas tank, etc.)
